THE HARYANA PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2013

ACT

further to amend the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Haryana in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

This Act may be called the Haryana Private Universities (Amendment) Short title. 1. Act, 2013.

In the Schedule to the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, after 2. serial number 9 and entries thereagainst, the following serial numbers and entries thereagainst shall be added, namely:--

With reference of your letter No. SGTU/UGC/04/2016/925 dated 11.04.2016 on the above subject, I am directed to inform you that Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University, Gurgaon has been established by an Act of State Legislature of Haryana as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus in regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever its required.

Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University, Gurgaon is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh. The University can not open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.

The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre.

THE UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION ACT, 1956

(3 of 1956)

[3rd March, 1956]

An Act to make provision for the co-ordination and determination of standards in Universities and for that purpose, to establish a University Grants Commission.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

CHAPTER I

PRELIMINARY

1. (1) This Act may be called the University Grants Comission Act, 1956.

Short title and commencement

- (2) It shall come into force on such date¹ as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.
- 2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires-
 - (a) "Commission" means the University Grants Commission established under section 4:
 - (b) "executive authority" in relation to a University, means the chief executive authority of the University (by whatever name called) in which the general administration of the University is vested;
 - (c) "Fund" means the Fund of the University Grants Commission constituted under section 16;
 - (d) "member' means a member of the University Grants Commission and includes the Chairman² (and Vice-Chairman];
 - (e) "prescribed' means prescribed by rules made under this Act;

Definitions

(Chapter I - Preliminary)

(f) "University" means a University established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act, and includes any such institution as may, in consultation with the University concerned, be recoginsed by the Commission in accordance with the regulations made in this behalf under this Act.

Application of Act to institutions for higher studies other than Universities 3. The Central Government may, on the advice of the Commission, declare by notification in the Official Gazette, that any institution for higher education, other than a University, shall be deemed to be a University for the purposes of this Act, and on such a declaration being made, all the provisions of this Act shall apply to such institution as if it were a University within the meaning of clause (f) of section 2.

CHAPTER II

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMISSION

Establishment of the Commission

- 4. (1) With effect from such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint, there shall be established a Commission by the name of the University Grants Commission.
 - (2) The said Commission shall be a body corporate having perpetual succession and a common seal, and shall by the said name sue and be sued.

Composition of the Commission

- ¹[5. (1) The Commission shall consist of -
 - (i) a Chairman,
 - (ii) a Vice-Chairman, and
 - (iii) ten other members,

to be appointed by the Central Government.

- (2) The Chairman shall be chosen from among persons who are not officers of the Central Government or of any State Government.
- (3) Of the other members referred to in clause (iii) of sub-section (1)
 - (a) two shall be chosen from among the officers of the Central Government, to represent that Government;
