

Course Content




1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program


Most FASC, SGT University students (over 73%) rated the relevance of their courses to their program as either 4 or 5 stars, indicating a high level of satisfaction. While a smaller portion gave lower ratings (a combined 26%), the majority opinion clearly shows that students largely feel their courses are relevant to their chosen programs. The relatively high number of 3-star ratings (nearly 19%) suggests a small area for potential improvement in ensuring all courses directly connect with program goals

2. Practicals/Labs are given equal importance

Most FASC, SGT University students believe practicals/labs are given a fair amount of importance in their courses. While a small percentage gave low ratings (1 or 2 stars), a significant majority rated the balance between theory and practical work as either good (3 stars) or very good (4 or 5 stars), with the highest number of students giving it a 4 or 5star rating. This suggests that while there's room for minor improvement based on the lower ratings, the overall perception is positive regarding the equal importance given to practical and theoretical learning



3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory



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
Most FASC, SGT University students found that the practical lab experiments helped them understand the theoretical concepts, with a significant portion rating them 4 or 5 stars. While a small percentage gave lower ratings (1 or 2 stars), the majority felt the practicals were effective learning tools, suggesting the labs are generally successful in reinforcing classroom learning.



4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry


Most students at FASC, SGT University, feel the course content is adequately preparing them for industry jobs, with a nearly even distribution of ratings between 3, 4, and 5 [•]stars. While a significant portion (28.57%) rated the course content as 'good' (3 stars), a substantial number also gave it higher marks (4 and 5 stars), indicating a generally positive perception of its effectiveness in enhancing technical skills. However, a notable minority expressed less satisfaction,

with a combined 17.54% giving it only 1 or 2 stars, suggesting some areas for improvement in aligning course content with industry needs.



4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry (FASC)


5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives


6. Rate Applicability/relevance of courses taught to real life situations & career advancement

3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers






Learning Environment

2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems




2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems (FASC)

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
3. The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion





Quality of Delivery




1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced


2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area


3. The syllabus was covered well within the time

1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time




1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time (FASC)

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
2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content


3. Rate your experience with the inclusion of Objective type Questions in the Exam paper

4. Rate your satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the university



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7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work




1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library

2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided








Course has good balance between theory and practical application (FASC)






Content of course is based on industry needs and demands (FASC)




Course content stimulate my interest in the subject area (FASC)






Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course content (FASC)

Freedom to design strategies/techniques for formative assessment Average: 4.58




The curriculum is updated time to time (FASC)


Freedom to innovate and adopt new teaching strategies/methods Average: 4.61



Freedom to innovate and adopt new teaching strategies/methods (FASC)








Adequate number of reference books are available in Library (FASC)

The feedback from FASC, SGT University teachers shows that the availability of appropriate audio-visual teaching aids in lecture theatres is largely positive. A significant majority (58%) rated the aids with the highest rating (5 stars), and a further substantial portion (35%) gave a 4-star rating, indicating a high level of satisfaction. 




Appropriate Teaching aids(audio-visual) are available in lecture theatres (FASC)


Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms- Percentage of theory and practical


Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.39





Alumni Feedback




Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.


How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job?

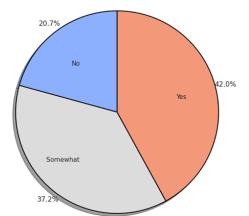
Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?


Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)




2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace? Average: 4.38

3. Teamwork and Communication: SGT graduates effective in team collaboration and clear in their verbal and written communication?





4. Professionalism and Ethical responsibility: Do SGT graduates exhibit ethical behavior and professionalism in their roles?




5. Adaptability and Initiative: How would you rate the adaptability and leadership potential of SGT graduates in your organization? Average: 4.38

6. Overall Satisfaction: How satisfied are you overall with the performance of SGT graduates? Average: 4.38



Professionals Feedback

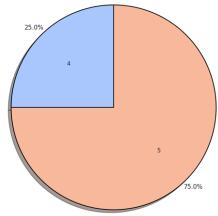
1. Syllabus content of course is based on industry needs and demands.


2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development. Average: 4.75

3. Content is focused on understanding of the practical/applied aspects of the theoretical concepts. Average: 4.5






4. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.

6. Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. Average: 4.5




Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. (Professionals)





7. Course content includes teaching about Professional ethics Average: 4.63





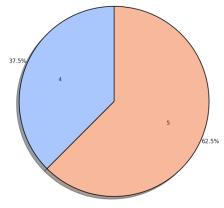
10. Training is imparted to develop administrative/managerial and leadership skills. Average: 4.63

Half of the respondents rated the curriculum a 4 out of 5 stars, while the other half gave it a perfect 5 out of 5 stars, indicating a strong consensus that the program successfully equips students with the necessary skills and knowledge for professional success.

Professionals SGT University at overwhelmingly approve of their training strategies' effectiveness in fostering a continuous learning attitude among students. The feedback shows a strong positive sentiment, with 75% giving a top rating of 5 stars and the remaining 25% giving a very positive 4-star rating. This indicates that the training programs are highly successful in cultivating a culture of ongoing learning and development within the student body.

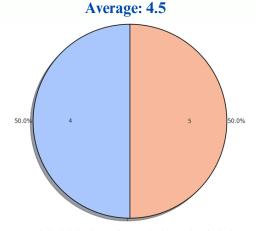
