



Student's Feedback

1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program




Most students at FDSC, SGT University find the courses relevant to their program. A significant majority (75.65%) rated the course relevance as 4 or 5 stars, indicating a high level of satisfaction. While a smaller portion of students gave lower ratings (a combined 5.16% gave 1 or 2 stars), the overall feedback suggests that the curriculum is largely aligned with program goals. The relatively high number of 3-star ratings (19.19%) suggests some room for improvement, potentially indicating that a few courses could be better aligned with student needs or expectations.


1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program (FDSC)

The feedback from FDSC, SGT University students regarding the equal importance given to practicals/labs shows a largely positive perception. While a small percentage gave lower ratings (1 or 2 stars), a significant majority rated the labs highly (4 or 5 stars), with almost half of respondents giving the highest possible rating of 5 stars. This suggests that students generally feel practicals and labs receive appropriate attention in their courses.



3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory



4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry




4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry (FDSC)


5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives

5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical and enhancing perspectives (FDSC)


6. Rate Applicability/relevance of courses taught to real life situations & career advancement

7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work




7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work (FDSC)

Learning resources


1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library

2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided




2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided (FDSC)

3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers




Learning Environment

2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems



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
3. The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion


4. Overall environment in the class is conducive to learning

1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced




1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced (FDSC)


2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area


3. The syllabus was covered well within the time

1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time




1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time (FDSC)


2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content

3. Rate your experience with the inclusion of Objective type Questions in the Exam paper




Rate your experience with the inclusion of Objective type Questions in the Exam pa (FDSC)


4. Rate your satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the university





A significant portion (22.22%) gave a very good rating (4 stars), further supporting the positive feedback. While a smaller number of teachers gave 3-star (3.7%) and 2-star (1.23%) ratings, the overall feedback strongly suggests that the courses effectively blend theoretical knowledge with practical application.


Course has good balance between theory and practical application (FDSC)





The overwhelming majority of FDSC teachers at SGT University (92.6% giving 4 or 5 stars) believe the curriculum is updated regularly. While a small percentage gave lower ratings (1 to 3 stars, totaling 7.4%), the feedback strongly suggests a positive perception of the curriculum's timeliness and relevance. The high number of 4 5-star ratings indicates widespread satisfaction with the curriculum update process.


Freedom to innovate and adopt new teaching strategies/methods Average: 4.64

The feedback from FDSC, SGT University teachers on their freedom to innovate teaching methods shows overwhelmingly positive results. A significant majority (69.14%) gave the highest rating of 5 stars, indicating a strong feeling of empowerment to try new approaches. While a smaller percentage rated it 4 stars (25.93%), the very low number of 2 and 3-star ratings (2.47% and 1.23% respectively) suggests that concerns about this aspect of teaching are minimal. Overall, the data indicates that teachers at FDSC Freedom to innovate and adopt new teaching strategies/methods (FDSfeel largely free to experiment with and implement

innovative teaching strategies.

Freedom to design strategies/techniques for formative assessment Average: 4.56



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


Adequate number of reference books are available in Library Average: 4.4

A substantial portion (28.4%) gave a 4star rating, indicating satisfaction. However, a noticeable number of teachers (7.41% gave 3 stars, suggesting some room for improvement), while a small percentage (2.47% each) rated it 1 or 2 stars, highlighting potential dissatisfaction among a minority of respondents with the library's reference book collection. Overall, the feedback leans positively towards the library's resources but indicates some areas needing attention to ensure complete satisfaction for all faculty

While a small percentage gave lower ratings (1-3 stars), a significant majority (over 90%) rated the aids 4 or 5 stars, indicating a high level of satisfaction with the resources provided. 

While a smaller portion rated the exams 3 or 4 stars (2.47% and 24.69% respectively), suggesting some areas for potential improvement, the overall sentiment points to a generally positive experience with the internal assessment process. Only a tiny fraction (1.23%) gave a 2-star rating.

Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms-Percentage of theory and practical Average: 4.49



Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.5



Overall environment in the department is conducive to teaching and learning Average: 4.62



Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.




Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you? (A

How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job?




How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job? (Alumni)


Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?

Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program help you in placement?




Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)




2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace? Average: 4.38

3. Teamwork and Communication: SGT graduates effective in team collaboration and clear in their verbal and written communication?







6. Overall Satisfaction: How satisfied are you overall with the performance of SGT graduates? Average: 4.38




6. Overall Satisfaction How satisfied are you overall with the performance of SGT graduates? (Employer)

1. Syllabus content of course is based on industry needs and demands.



2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development.



3. Content is focused on understanding of the practical/applied aspects of the theoretical concepts. Average: 4.5






4. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.

6. Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. Average: 4.5








Course content includes teaching about Professional ethics (Professionals)






