



Course Content

1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program




Most students at FEAT, SGT University, find the courses relevant to their program, with a significant portion rating them as 3 or 4 stars. While a considerable number gave positive 4 and 5-star ratings, a concerning number of students also gave lower ratings of 1, 2, and 3 stars, suggesting some feel the course relevance could be improved. The relatively high proportion of 3-star ratings indicates a need to investigate areas for improvement to increase student satisfaction with course relevance.

2. Practicals/Labs are given equal importance

Most students at FEAT, SGT University feel that practicals and labs are given a fair amount of importance in their courses. While a significant portion rated them highly (4 and 5 stars), a considerable number also gave average ratings (3 stars), suggesting room for improvement in ensuring equal emphasis across all practical components. A smaller number of students felt practicals/labs could be better (1 and 2 stars). Overall, the feedback leans towards a positive perception but indicates a need for continued effort to ensure consistent quality and importance given to practical learning.

that the practical lab experiments were helpful


in understanding the theoretical concepts, with

support all students




4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry




Most students at FEAT, SGT University, believe the course content improves their technical skills for industry jobs, with a significant portion (30.3%) giving a 4-star rating. While a smaller percentage rated it 1 or 2 stars (12.12% and 15.15% respectively), indicating some areas for improvement, a considerable number (nearly 42%) rated it 3 stars or higher, suggesting the course content is generally effective in preparing students for industry challenges. The high proportion of 4 and 5-star ratings (53.03%) points to overall student satisfaction with the technical skill development aspect of the course.

5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives

Most students at FEAT, SGT University found the course useful in terms of knowledge, analytical skills, and broadened perspectives, with a significant portion (35% combined) giving it a 4 or 5-star rating. While a considerable number (31%) rated it 3 stars, suggesting it met their expectations, a smaller group (around 16%) felt it was less useful, giving it 1 or 2 stars. Overall, the feedback indicates a generally positive perception of the course's effectiveness, although there's room for improvement to better meet the needs of the students who rated it lower.



Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical at and enhancing perspectives (FEAT)




6. Rate Applicability/relevance of courses taught to real life situations & career advancement

7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work




Most students at FEAT, SGT University, are satisfied with the availability of internship and fieldwork opportunities, with over half giving a 4 or 5-star rating. 
1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library

Most students at FEAT, SGT University, feel that the library has a reasonably good selection of reference books, with over half giving it a 3, 4, or 5star rating. However, a significant portion (around 20%) rated it only 1 or 2 stars, indicating a need for improvement in the library's reference book collection to better satisfy all student needs. While a majority are satisfied, a considerable number of students clearly believe more or better reference books are needed




2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided (FEAT)

The distribution of ratings shows a general satisfaction, but also highlights a need to address the concerns of those who found the materials less helpful.



3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers



Learning Environment


1. Teaching methods encourage your participation in learning

Most students at FEAT, SGT University, gave average to slightly above average ratings regarding how well teaching methods encouraged their participation. While a significant portion (29.55%) rated it as "3 stars" (neutral), a similar number (25.76%) gave it the highest rating of "5 stars", showing some instructors are highly effective at engaging students. However, a considerable number of students (12.88%) gave it a "2-star" rating, suggesting a need to improve teaching approaches to better involve a portion of the student body. The combined "1-star" and "2-star" ratings indicate a need to address student concerns about their level of engagement in class.


2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems



Most students at FEAT, SGT University, feel their teachers are responsive to their needs and problems. A significant majority (39.39% gave 4 stars and 26.52% gave 5 stars), indicating positive experiences. While a smaller percentage gave lower ratings (5.3% gave 1 star, 3.79% gave 2 stars, and 25% gave 3 stars), the overall feedback suggests a generally positive perception of teacher responsiveness. The relatively low number of 1 and 2-star ratings indicates that while there's room for improvement for a minority of students, the majority find their teachers supportive.



3. The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion




3. The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion (FEAT)


4. Overall environment in the class is conducive to learning

Quality of Delivery




1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced

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
2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area

3. The syllabus was covered well within the time



1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time





2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content





4. Rate your satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the university










Course has good balance between theory and practical application Average: 4.2




Course has good balance between theory and practical application (FEAT)


Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development. Average: 4.27






Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course content (FEAT)


Freedom to design strategies/techniques for formative assessment Average: 4.34

Freedom to design strategies/techniques for formative assessment (FEAT)






Appropriate Teaching aids(audio-visual) are available in lecture theatres Average: 4.05


Adequate number of reference books are available in Library Average: 3.82




Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms-Percentage of theory and practical Average: 4.21

Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms- Percentage of theory and practical (FEAT)






Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.12


Overall environment in the department is conducive to teaching and learning Average: 4.34

Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.



Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you? (Al

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
How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job?


Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?


Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)




2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace? Average: 4.38



4. Professionalism and Ethical responsibility: Do SGT graduates exhibit ethical behavior and professionalism in their roles?




5. Adaptability and Initiative: How would you rate the adaptability and leadership potential of SGT graduates in your organization? Average: 4.38



1. Syllabus content of course is based on industry needs and demands.




2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development. Average: 4.75

3. Content is focused on understanding of the practical/applied aspects of the theoretical concepts. Average: 4.5






4. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.







7. Course content includes teaching about Professional ethics Average: 4.63








