






Students Feedback

Course Content

1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program




Most students at FEDU, SGT University find the courses relevant to their programs. A significant majority (45.76%) gave the highest rating of 5 stars, and another large portion (26.27%) rated them 4 stars. While a smaller number of students gave lower ratings (24.58% gave 3 stars and 3.39% gave 2 stars), the overall feedback indicates a strong perception of course relevance within the university's programs.

2. Practicals/Labs are given equal importance

Most students at FEDU and SGT University feel that practicals and labs are given equal importance, with almost 70% rating them 4 or 5 stars. While a significant portion of students are satisfied, there's still a notable number (around 12%) giving lower ratings (1 or 2 stars), suggesting room for improvement in ensuring all students have a positive experience with practical components of their education. The majority opinion, however, indicates a generally positive perception of the balance between theory and practical learning



3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory

Most students at FEDU and SGT University felt that the practical lab experiments helped them understand the theoretical concepts, with nearly 40% giving the highest rating of 5 stars. A significant portion (almost 30%) gave a 4star rating, showing generally positive feedback. While a smaller percentage gave lower ratings (1, 2, and 3 stars), the data indicates that, overall, the practicals were effective in enhancing students' learning experience.



4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry




Most students at FEDU and SGT University felt the course content effectively enhanced their technical skills for the industry, with over 64% giving it a 4 or 5-star rating. While a significant portion found it helpful, a notable minority (around 35%) rated it 3 stars or lower, suggesting room for improvement in aligning the curriculum with industry needs for a more substantial number of students.


4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry (FEDU)

Most students (45.76%) found the course very useful in terms of knowledge, analytical skills, and broadened perspectives, giving it a 5-star rating. Overall, the feedback indicates a generally positive perception of the course's effectiveness in achieving its learning objectives, although a notable minority found it less impactful.




6. Rate Applicability/relevance of courses taught to real-life situations & career advancement

Most students at FEDU and SGT University feel the courses' relevance to real-life situations and career advancement is good to excellent, with over 66% rating them 4 or 5 stars. While a significant portion (26%) gave a neutral 3-star rating, relatively few students felt the courses were poorly applicable (less than 7% gave 1 or 2 stars). Overall, the feedback indicates a generally positive perception of the courses' practical value and career benefits, though there's room for improvement to address the concerns of the smaller group giving lower ratings.



7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work




Most students at FEDU and SGT University (almost 70%) rated the availability of internship and fieldwork opportunities as either good (4 stars) or excellent (5 stars). 1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library


Most students at FEDU and SGT University (33.05%) rated the availability of reference books in the library as excellent (5 stars), and a significant portion (27.12%) rated it as good (3 stars). However, a considerable number of students also gave lower ratings, indicating that a substantial minority felt the library's reference book collection was inadequate (7.63% gave it the lowest rating of 1 star). This suggests that while many students are satisfied, improvements are needed to address the concerns of those who find the library's resources lacking.

2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided



3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers





Learning Environment


1. Teaching methods encourage your participation in learning ²⁵

1. Teaching methods encourage your participation in learning (FEDU)


2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems

3. The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion



4. Overall environment in the class is conducive to learning



1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced



1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced (FEDU)




2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area





3. The syllabus was covered well within the time



1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time




1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time (FEDU)

2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content






Rate your satisfaction with **4**. the examination and evaluation pattern of the university








Teacher's Feedback

Course content stimulate my interest in the subject area (FEDU)




Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development. (FEDU)



Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development. Average: 4.8







Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course content




Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course content (FEDU)


Freedom to design strategies/techniques for formative assessment Average: 4.5






Adequate number of reference books are available in Library Average: 3.7




Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms-Percentage of theory and practical Average: 4.5

Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.5




Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University (FEDU)

Overall environment in the department is conducive to teaching and learning Average: 4.6




Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.

Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you? (A




How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with • respect to your current job?




Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?

Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)






2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace ? Average: 4.38

3. Teamwork and Communication: SGT graduates effective in team collaboration and clear in their verbal and written communication ?



4. Professionalism and Ethical responsibility: Do SGT graduates exhibit ethical behavior and professionalism in their roles?




5. Adaptability and Initiative: How would you rate the adaptability and leadership potential of SGT graduates in your organization? Average: 4.38




1. Syllabus content of course is based on industry needs and demands.


2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development. Average: 4.75








Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. (Professionals)








8. Training strategies develop a constant learning attitude among the students.


10. Training is imparted to develop administrative/managerial and leadership skills. Average: 4.63


