



Course Content

1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program




Most students at FMMT, SGT University, find the courses relevant to their program. A significant majority (71.43%) rated the course relevance as 4 or 5 stars, indicating a high level of satisfaction. While a smaller portion gave lower ratings (1 and 2 stars), the prevalent positive feedback suggests that the curriculum effectively aligns with program objectives. The moderate number of 3-star ratings might indicate room for minor improvements to further enhance course relevance for all students.


1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program (FMMT)

2. Practicals/Labs are given equal importance

Students at FMMT, SGT University, largely feel that practicals and labs are given significant importance, with most students (over 65%) rating this aspect as either 4 or 5 stars. While a notable portion (around 17%) gave a neutral 3-star rating, relatively few students rated it poorly (around 17% gave 1 or 2 stars). Overall, the feedback suggests a generally positive perception of the balance between theory and practical learning in the program, though there's room for improvement to address concerns raised by the smaller group of less satisfied students.




3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory



Most students at FMMT, SGT University found that the practical lab experiments significantly helped them understand the theoretical concepts, with almost half (45.71%) giving the highest rating of 5 stars. While a smaller percentage gave lower ratings (2.86% gave 1 star, and 11.43% gave 2 stars), a substantial majority (31.43% gave 4 stars, and 8.57% gave 3 stars) indicated that the labs were helpful, suggesting the practicals are generally effective in enhancing learning but there's room for improvement for a small minority.

4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry




5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives

5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives (FMMT)



• 7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work






1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library

2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided





3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers






1. Teaching methods encourage your participation in learning

2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems




2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems (FMMT)

4. Overall environment in the class is conducive to learning




1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced

2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area




The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area (FMMT)


3. The syllabus was covered well within the time


1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time

2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content




3. Rate your experience with the inclusion of Objective type Questions in the Exam paper


Content of course is based on industry needs and demands. Average: 4.5




Course has good balance between theory and practical application (FMMT)


Course content stimulate my interest in the subject area. Average: 4.17




Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course content. Average: 4.5



Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course content (FMMT)











Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms-Percentage of theory and practical Average: 4.33




Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms- Percentage of theory and practical (FMMT)


Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.33

Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University (FMMT)


Overall environment in the department is conducive to teaching and learning Average: 4.5

Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.




Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you? (Al


How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job?


Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?

Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program help you in placement?




Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)



2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace?



3. Teamwork and Communication: SGT graduates effective in team collaboration and clear in their verbal and written communication?





4. Professionalism and Ethical responsibility: Do SGT graduates exhibit ethical behavior and professionalism in their roles?





5. Adaptability and Initiative: How would you rate the adaptability and leadership potential of SGT graduates in your organization? Average: 4.38







2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development.







6. Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. Average: 4.5





While a quarter (25%) gave it a good rating (4 stars), a smaller portion (12.5%) gave a neutral rating (3 stars), suggesting room for minor improvements but overall high satisfaction with the curriculum's up-to-date content.




Course content includes teaching about Professional ethics (Professionals)








Emphasis is given on developing communication and other soft skills. (Professionals)
