



#### **Course Content**

#### 1. Rate whether courses offered are relevant to the Program




Most students at FOL, SGT University find the courses relevant to their program. A significant majority (over 70%) rated the course relevance as 4 or 5 stars, indicating a high level of satisfaction. While a smaller portion gave lower ratings (1-3 stars), the overall feedback suggests that the curriculum is largely perceived as relevant and valuable by the student body.


#### 2. Practicals/Labs are given equal importance

Most students at FOL, SGT University, believe that practicals/labs receive equal importance in their courses. While a significant portion (34.65%) gave the highest rating of 5 stars, a considerable number also gave lower ratings, indicating some dissatisfaction. The distribution shows a positive skew, meaning a larger percentage of students rated the importance of practicals/labs higher than average. However, the substantial number of 1 and 2-star ratings suggest that a non-negligible portion of students feel that practicals/labs are not given sufficient attention.

#### 3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory




3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory

Most students at FOL, SGT University found that the practical lab experiments helped them understand the theoretical concepts, with nearly 40% giving the highest rating of 5 stars. A significant portion (around 25%) gave 4 stars, indicating a generally positive experience. While a smaller number of students rated the practicals lower (with 7.43% giving 1 star and 5.45% giving 2 stars), the overall feedback suggests that the lab experiments are effective in enhancing learning for the majority of students.




#### 4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry



The feedback from FOL, SGT University students on how well course content prepares them for industry jobs shows mostly positive results. While a small percentage gave lower ratings (1 and 2 stars), a significant majority rated the course content highly (4 and 5 stars), indicating that students largely feel their technical skills are being enhanced for their future careers. 
### 5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives

. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilit and enhancing perspectives (FOL)


### 6. Rate Applicability/relevance of courses taught to real life situations & career advancement



Most students at FOL, SGT University, find applicability to real-life courses' situations and career advancement to be good or excellent, with over 70% giving a 4 or 5star rating. While a significant portion finds them relevant (30.2% gave 4 stars), a large majority (40.59%) rated them highly relevant (5 stars). However, a notable minority (around 9% combined) felt the courses were less applicable, giving them 1 or 2 stars, suggesting room for improvement in connecting practical coursework experience and future career prospects.


7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work (FOL)

Most students at FOL, SGT University (45.54%) rated the availability of internship and fieldwork opportunities as excellent (5 stars), showing strong satisfaction. A significant portion (25.25%) gave a 4-star rating, indicating a generally positive experience. While a smaller number of students rated it lower (with 22.28% giving 3 stars, 4.46% giving 2 stars, and 2.48% giving only 1 star), the overall feedback suggests that opportunities for internships and fieldwork are largely well-received and considered a strength of the program

#### Learning resources


#### 1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library

Most students at FOL, SGT University (44.55%) rated the library's collection of reference books as excellent (5 stars), indicating a high level of satisfaction. A significant portion (29.7%) gave a 4-star rating, suggesting that while generally positive, there's room for improvement. Fewer students gave lower ratings (with only around 10% rating it as 1 or 2 stars), implying that while some students experienced difficulties, the overall availability of reference books is considered reasonably good.

#### 2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided



Students at FOL, SGT University, gave mixed feedback on the availability of appropriate reference materials. While a significant portion (38.12%) rated the materials highly (5 stars), a number considerable also expressed dissatisfaction, with nearly 16% giving it a 1 or 2-star rating. The most common rating was 3 stars (23.27%), suggesting that while many found the resources adequate, there's room for improvement to meet the needs of all students. Overall, the feedback indicates a need to address the concerns of students who felt the reference materials were insufficient.



#### 3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers




3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers (FOL)

#### 1. Teaching methods encourage your participation in learning



#### 2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems





#### 4. Overall environment in the class is conducive to learning



#### 1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced




1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced (FOL)

#### 2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area



#### 3. The syllabus was covered well within the time




#### 1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time



Most students at FOL, SGT University (45.54%) felt that tests and examinations were conducted well within the allotted time, indicating a positive experience. A significant portion (29.21%) also rated the time management of tests and exams highly with a 4-star rating. While fewer students gave lower ratings, a considerable number (7.43% and 3.47%) expressed some dissatisfaction with the time allocation, suggesting that improvements could still be made to ensure all students feel they have sufficient time. Overall, the feedback leans positive, but there's room for addressing concerns raised by the smaller groups.



### 2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content




2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course


#### 3. Rate your experience with the inclusion of Objective type Questions in the Exam paper




#### Teacher's Feedback


#### Course has good balance between theory and practical applicationAverage: 4.35





#### Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development. Average: 4.41






#### The curriculum is updated time to timeAverage: 4.71


#### Freedom to propose, suggest, modify topics in syllabus/ course contentAverage: 4.65





#### Freedom to design strategies/techniques for formative assessmentAverage: 4.65






#### Adequate number of reference books are available in Library Average: 4.41


#### Appropriate Teaching aids(audio-visual) are available in lecture theatres Average: 4.47





Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms- Percentage of theory and practical Average: 4.59






### Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.41


### Overall environment in the department is conducive to teaching and learning Average: 4.59


#### Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.

### How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job?




How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with respect to your current job? (Alumni)


#### Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?

#### Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program help you in placement?




Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)




# 2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace? Average: 4.38

### 3. Teamwork and Communication: SGT graduates effective in team collaboration and clear in their verbal and written communication?



# 5. Adaptability and Initiative: How would you rate the adaptability and leadership potential of SGT graduates in your organization? Average: 4.38





#### 1. Syllabus content of course is based on industry needs and demands.



#### 2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development.


#### Average: 4.75


### 3. Content is focused on understanding of the practical/applied aspects of the theoretical concepts. Average: 4.5




### 4. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.








Course content includes teaching about Professional ethics (Professionals)




Training strategies develops a constant learning attitude among the students.




