



Course Content




Most FPHY students at SGT University find the courses offered to be relevant to their program. While a small percentage rated the relevance as low (1 or 2 stars), a significant majority rated it as good to excellent (4 or 5 stars), with almost 76% giving a 4 or 5-star rating. The data suggests a generally positive perception of course relevance among the student body, though there's room for improvement based on the responses indicating less-than-perfect relevance.




Most FPHY students at SGT University found that the lab experiments helped them understand the


3. The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory


4. Course content enhances technical skills to face the industry




Most FPHY students at SGT University feel the course content is good at preparing them for industry jobs, with over two-thirds rating it 4 or 5 stars. While a significant portion found it very helpful (42.57% gave it 4 stars and 23.69% gave it 5 stars), a noticeable minority (around 11% combined) felt it was only somewhat helpful (2 stars) or not very helpful (1 star), suggesting room for improvement in certain aspects of the curriculum to better align with industry needs.

5. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilities and enhancing perspectives

Most FPHY students at SGT University found the course useful, with a significant portion (39.36%) rating it as 4 out of 5 stars and a considerable number (31.73%) giving it the highest rating of 5 stars. While a smaller percentage rated it lower (2.81% gave it 1 star, 7.23% gave it 2 stars, and 18.88% gave it 3 stars), the overall feedback suggests that the course effectively enhanced students' knowledge, analytical skills, and perspectives. The majority of students had a positive experience with the course's impact on their learning.



. Rate usefulness of the course in terms of knowledge concepts and analytical abilit and enhancing perspectives (FPHY)




6. Rate Applicability/relevance of courses taught to real-life situations & career

While a smaller percentage rated them as only fair (3 stars), a very small portion felt the courses were not very applicable (1 or 2 stars). Overall, the feedback suggests a positive perception of the courses' practical value and career benefits.



7. Availability of opportunities to participate in internship and field work






1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library

1. Adequate reference books are available in the Library (FPHY)


2. Appropriate reference material (print & online) is provided

3. Rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools in the class by teachers




Learning Environment

^{1.} Teaching methods encourage your participation in learning (FPHY)




2. Teacher is responsive to students needs and problems


3. The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion






1. The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced

Most FPHY students at SGT University felt the syllabus content was appropriately sequenced, with a significant portion rating it 4 or 5 stars (37.35% and 28.11% respectively). While a smaller number gave lower ratings (3.21% gave it 1 star and 7.63% gave it 2 stars), a substantial portion (23.69%) rated it a neutral 3 stars, suggesting that while generally well-received, there's still room for minor improvements to the syllabus sequencing to better satisfy all students.






2. The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area


3. The syllabus was covered well within the time

1. Tests and examinations are conducted well within time



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
2. The sequence of internal/sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course









The feedback from FPHY teachers at SGT University overwhelmingly indicates a positive perception of the balance between theory and practical application in their courses. While a small percentage gave a 3-star rating (4.35%), the vast majority rated it highly, with almost two-thirds (60.87%) giving it a 5-star rating and a significant portion (34.78%) awarding 4 stars. This suggests that the curriculum effectively integrates theoretical knowledge with hands-on experience, a key strength of the program.




Course has good balance between theory and practical application Average: 4.57









The curriculum is updated time to time (FPHY)






Appropriate Teaching aids(audio-visual) are available in lecture theatres Average: 4.65


Internal/sessional examinations are conducted in time with adequate coverage of all syllabus Average: 4.74

Level of satisfaction with Examination reforms- Percentage of theory and practical (FPHY)




Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University Average: 4.61



Rate your level of satisfaction with the examination and evaluation pattern of the University (FPHY)




Adequate number of reference books are available in Library





Alumni Feedback




Rate your level of satisfaction with the course curriculum delivered to you.

How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum of your degree/diploma program with • respect to your current job?







Did you get sufficient placement opportunities through the institution?

Did the curriculum of your degree/diploma program helped you in placement? (Alumni)






2. Problem solving and Critical Thinking: How well do SGT Graduates demonstrate problem solving and critical thinking skills in the workplace? Average: 4.38



4. Professionalism and Ethical responsibility: Do SGT graduates exhibit ethical behavior and professionalism in their roles?




5. Adaptability and Initiative: How would you rate the adaptability and leadership potential of SGT graduates in your organization? Average: 4.38




1. Syllabus content of course is based on industry needs and demands.


2. Emphasis is given on professional skill development. Average: 4.75

3. Content is focused on understanding of the practical/applied aspects of the theoretical concepts. Average: 4.5

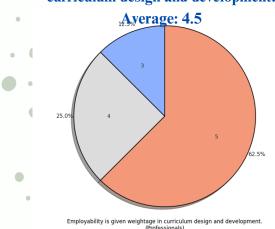




4. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.

6. Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. Average: 4.5




Syllabus content imparts knowledge and understanding of advanced/latest techniques/developments. (Professionals)

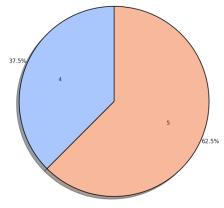
10. Training is imparted to develop administrative/managerial and leadership skills. Average: 4.63


9. Emphasis is given on developing communication and other soft skills. Average: 4.63
