Other Major Points:

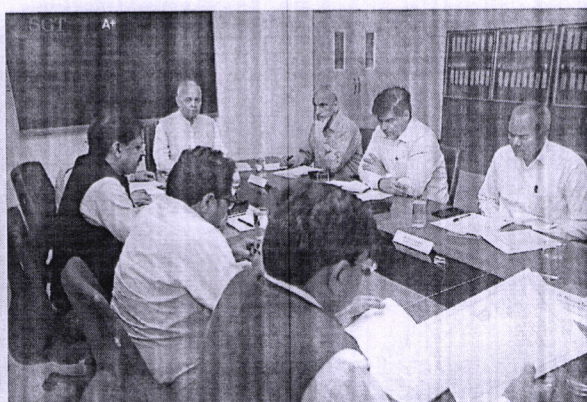

Two additional points were also discussed:-

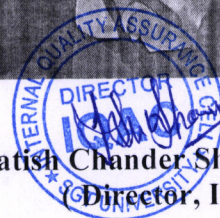
1. CII they have various programs and the University should contact them.
