This memorandum records the intention of School of Physiotherapy, School of Nursing, School of Nutrition and Dietetics, School of Medical Laboratory Technology, Binawan Institute of Health Sciences (BIHS) Jakarta, Indonesia and the Faculty of Physiotherapy, Faculty of Allied Health Sciences, Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University (SGT), Gurugram, Haryana, India to strengthen ties between the two institutions which might lead in future to the establishment of one or more partnership agreements for for exchange purpose, academic cooperation or the delivery of Binawan Institute of Health Sciences (BIHS) Jakarta, Indonesia and Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University (SGT), Gurugram, Haryana, India for joint academic and research programs. All collaborations for research and otherwise shall be done in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of both the countries and after seeking appropriate approvals from the regulating bodies as may be applicable for the particular situation.

At present this agreement is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two institutions, which may see the development of the links in the areas of:

- (a) Learning and teaching including the development of academic programs and clinical practices.
- (b) Exchange of students and faculty.

- (c) Development of joint academic programs for undergraduate and post-graduate students.
- (d) Development of collaborative research projects.

Details of implementation of any particular collaborative agreement leading to an award shall be negotiated between the two institutions when specific case arises. Such an agreement will be legitimized by the completion of a joint Memorandum of Understanding.

Not with standing any other provisions, this MOU only expresses the intention of the two institutions. These expressed intentions are not binding and no legal obligations are intended, or do arise as a consequence of the signing of this document.

This MOU is valid from the date of execution by the Parties and shall remain in effect for five (5) years.

This MOU is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent of both parties in writing.

Any amendment to this MOU may be made in writing subject to mutual consent of both parties.
