



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**SHREE GURU GOBIND SINGH TRICENTENARY UNIVERSITY (SGT) GURUGRAM-  
BADLI ROAD CHANDU, BUDHERA, GURUGRAM, HARYANA, INDIA**

**AND  
CYBER THREAT HARYANA - PANIPAT, HARYANA**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to in short as “MoU”) is entered on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2025 by and between:

Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University (SGTU), Gurugram, India and Cyber Threat Haryana - Panipat, Haryana, India wish to establish co-operative relations between the two institutions, especially to develop the academic research links/collaboration/Industrial Training opportunities and cultural interchange between the two institutions through mutual assistance in the areas of education, research, internships, training, faculty/expert exchange, capacity building and others.

**Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University (SGT UNIVERSITY), situated at Gurugram represented by the Registrar, University, (hereinafter referred to as “University” which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as FIRST PARTY.**

**AND**

**CYBER THREAT HARYANA, situated at PANIPAT represented by Founder, Cyber threat Haryana, Panipat (hereinafter referred to as “CYBER THREAT HARYANA” which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as SECOND PARTY. (Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as “Parties” and individually as a “Party”)**

## **1. About SGT University**

Shri Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University is a private University in Gurugram, Haryana. The University came into existence by the Haryana Private Universities (Amendment) Act No. 8 of 2013 making educational opportunities available to all segments of society, under the parasol of Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust, found in 1999. In fact, the seeds for magnificent growth were sown way back in 2002 with establishment of SGT Dental College.

The University is providing education in various disciplines, which is relevant for today's health care needs & highly competitive global market. The University offers a unique blend of theoretical & practical training & cutting-edge technology to students, making them technically well-rounded professionals.

The University wishes to establish a learning environment that shall motivate the students to explore their levels of potential & its related scope in their respective fields. The Mission is to develop with great sense of esthetics, a learning stimulating environment. The futuristic curriculum is specially designed to cater to the needs of present era & also prepare the students on application fronts in working as a team with ethical, morals & professional liabilities. SGTU believes in overall holistic development of our students as well as the faculty in every discipline, so that they can perform their responsibilities in the community in best manner.

## **2. ABOUT CYBER THREAT HARYANA, HARYANA, INDIA**

Cyber Threat Haryana, is dedicated to enhance the cyber security landscape in Panipat and the surrounding regions. The organization caters comprehensive services to various sectors, including government, law enforcement, and private enterprises. Cyber Threat Haryana is an organization registered on MSME India with registration number: UDYAM-HR-14-0036928.

This organization as per National Industry Classification Code(s) provides the services as 1) 85212- General School education in the second stage of the secondary level (Senior/Higher secondary) giving, in principle, access to higher education. 2) 85302- Higher education in engineering/ other technical courses leading to a university degree or equivalent. An overview of the key offerings from the organization is:

### **2.1. Diploma Courses in Cyber Security and Digital Forensics**

We have partnered with a state government university to launch diploma courses in Cyber Security and Digital Forensics. This initiative, established through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), aims to equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge to combat cyber threats effectively.



## **2.2. Training for Haryana Police Academy**

The organization provides specialized training programs for the Haryana Police Academy, focusing on the latest techniques in cybercrime investigation and digital forensics including Open-Source Intelligence (OSINT), New IT Acts 2023 (BNS, BNSS, BSA). These training sessions are designed to empower law enforcement officials with the tools and knowledge required to tackle cybercrime efficiently.

## **2.3. Collaboration with Haryana Institute of Public Administration**

The organization in collaboration with the Haryana Institute of Public Administration delivers training on cyber security and the digital environment with an aim to enhance the understanding of cyber threats and promote best practices in digital safety among public administration officials.

## **2.4. Cyber Crime Awareness Programs**

The organization organizes awareness programs in collaboration with government agencies to educate the public about cybercrime with a focus on Identifying potential cyber threats, Understanding the importance of cyber hygiene, and promoting safe online practices

## **2.5. Cyber Security and Penetration Testing Services for the Private Sector**

In addition, working with government entities, the organization offers cyber security and penetration testing services to private sector organizations including Vulnerability assessments, Security audits, Incident response planning.

## **3. Scope of Cooperation:**

The areas of cooperation include, subject to mutual consent, programmes offered at both institutions as felt desirable and feasible on either side, or that both sides contribute to fostering and development of the cooperative relationships between the two institutions. The assistance to be provided by each of the parties will be teaching, research, students/faculty training, internships, guest lectures, exchange of faculty and students, cultural exchange and staff development, as deemed beneficial by the two institutions. Upon reaching agreement on specific projects, the parties shall document their understanding of the specific terms of each project in a written agreement to be signed by both parties.

### **3.1. General Area of Cooperation:**

Assistance shall be carried out subject to the advance written approval through such activities or programmes as:



- 3.1.1. To strengthen the curriculum offered at SGT University, drawing from the rich professional experience and expertise in the areas of Forensic science, Cyber/Digital Forensics, and Information Security.
- 3.1.2. To provide Certifications- CFE, CCNA, CEH with AI, CHFI, Digital Forensic, OPEN-SOURCE INTELLIGENCE, PYTHON with AI and ONE CYBER LAW TRAINING at the reasonable costing as decided by both the parties on mutual consent.
- 3.1.3. To identify and support internship/training/placement opportunities in different areas of Digital Forensics, Forensic Science, and Information Security to the students from SGT University, Gurugram.
- 3.1.4. To provide hands-on experience in a real-time environment to make students at SGT University, job ready.
- 3.1.5. To support in organizing guest lectures, workshops, and seminars in emerging topics in the field of Digital/Cyber Forensics and Information Security.
- 3.1.6. To conduct joint research & development, co-author articles for publication in peer reviewed journals.


#### **4. Term of Cooperation**

4.1 This Memorandum of Understanding is for a period of 5 years and is effective from ... 10-05-2025 and shall remain in force till 09-05-2030. This MoU may be further extended on terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed by both the parties.

4.2. The parties have recognized each other of working in collaboration with each other in the sphere of promotion of cyber and Digital education and wish to encourage the people to be aware about the means of protection from cyber threats. The programmes will have intake of (to start with the programmes) 25 minimum students strength in each training.

#### **5. Financial Terms (For the Course/Certifications offered by Cyber Threat Haryana)**

- 5.1. The student will deposit the fee in the designated fee account of the First Party i.e SGT University. SGTU will get 35% Share Compulsory for Admission process, Infrastructure maintenance, Lab with necessary equipment and Examination activities etc.
- 5.2. The Second Party Cyber Threat Haryana will get 65% Share compulsory for salary to faculty engaged for Teaching & Learning, Training, Procuring, and installing tools for practical knowledge of Courses to students, Full Practical, Live working Experience etc.
- 5.3. The second party shall be responsible for payment of salary, allowances, TA/DA etc. to the engaged faculty, resource person, invited guests for the purpose of the knowledge enhancement of the students. The disbursement of the salary, allowances shall be made online, and by following the rules and regulations as notified by the Govt. of Haryana from time to time.



5.4. The share of second party will be transferred on one-time basis and the process of transfer of funds will start immediately after the commencement of classes for the certificate courses mentioned above (in clause 3.1.2.) subject to admissions/participations in the courses. The fee or share will not be applicable for any other program/courses offered by SGT University.

5.5. The fee for the session for the certificate courses mentioned above (in clause 3.1.2.) will be 25,000/-. The fee structure will be prepared by the SGT University in consultation with CYBER THREAT HARYANA and will be reviewed each year.

## **6. Intellectual & Technical Property Rights**

In the course of collaboration between SGTU and Cyber Threat Haryana, participating individuals using proprietary materials and technologies acquired by either institution must adhere to intellectual property (IP) and technical property (TP) protection (e.g. material transfer agreement (TA) or license) pertaining to the relevant technologies and material. Neither Party shall use any trademarks, logos, trade names or any other Intellectual Property of the other Party or a third party in any manner whatsoever without the prior written approval of the other Party or the relevant third party (as may be required)

Protection of innovation, research products and other IP/TP (through patents, knowledge production right, or other means) accruing from joint collaboration between SGTU and Cyber Threat Haryana will be done jointly following consultations with the relevant institutional IP/TP organs/panels on proprietary science and technology. Ownership and management of all TP and IP resulting from any collaboration shall be addressed in the written agreement governing each project.

## **7. Representation and Warranties**

Each Party hereby represents to the other that they have been duly incorporated/ registered under the applicable laws and has full legal right and authority to execute this memorandum of understanding. Each Party represents that it is also authorized to perform its obligations as herein contemplated; and that neither the performance of the obligations or execution of this MoU will violate or in violation of any applicable laws for the time being in force.

Cyber Threat Haryana represents and warrants that:

- (i) it, its personnel and third parties engaged by it for the due discharge of its obligations hereunder, have the requisite skill, competence, experience, expertise, as per best industry standards to provide the Services under this Agreement;
- (ii) the Services provided under this Agreement when used for the purpose for which it is intended shall not infringe any third-party Intellectual Property rights or violate any applicable laws.



- (iii) the content and/ or services delivered under the Programs and/ or any other programs delivered under this Agreement will be performed in a professional and workman like manner, in accordance with best industry practices. Cyber Threat Haryana further represents and warrants that services and programs will be delivered in accordance with their specifications and acceptable industry standards

#### **8. Confidentiality**

The parties shall severally take care to ensure that the information provided by the other party remains confidential and further agree not to use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which it is intended. The parties shall not disclose any Confidential Information to anyone other than the employees of either organization who need to know the Confidential Information. Each Party recognizes such information of the other Party as confidential information and agrees not to disclose them to any third party without the prior written consent of the other Party. The restriction contained in this clause shall not be applicable to information which:

- (i) Is required to be provided pursuant to any statutory or regulatory obligation;
- (ii) Is lawfully acquired by the disclosing Party from an independent source having no obligation to maintain the confidentiality of such information; and
- (iii) Was lawfully known to the disclosing Party prior to its disclosure under this Agreement.

Cyber Threat Haryana acknowledges, agrees and undertakes that it will be deemed to be the Data Fiduciary as per the provisions of Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 (DPDP Act) for all the personal information/data furnished to or accessed by Cyber Threat Haryana under this MOU. Cyber Threat Haryana further agrees and undertakes to ensure compliance with all the provisions applicable to data fiduciaries for processing the aforesaid personal information in accordance with DPDP Act. Cyber Threat Haryana further agrees and undertakes that any such data will be kept secret and confidential and retained or processed in accordance with the applicable data protection legislation including but not limited to DPDP Act and must not be passed on to any other agency or individual other than any person authorised by Customer.

#### **9. Renewal, Termination and Amendment**

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that either party giving 30 days written notice to the other party in any year may terminate it. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties.

The expiration or termination of this Agreement for any reason will not release Parties from any liabilities or obligations set forth herein which (a) the Parties have expressly agreed will survive



any such expiration or termination; or (b) remain to be performed; or (c) by their nature are intended to survive expiry or termination of the Agreement

This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by written amendment signed by the authorized persons at each institution.

#### **10. Limitation of Liability**

For the purposes of this memorandum of agreement encompassing specific programs and services between SGTU and Cyber Threat Haryana. It is understood and agreed that neither party shall be liable for any negligent or wrongful acts, either of commission or omission, chargeable to the other, unless such liability is imposed by law. This MoU shall not be construed as seeking to either enlarge or diminish any obligation or duty owed by one party to the other or to a third party. The agreement shall be binding upon signing by authorized individuals of SGTU and Cyber Threat Haryana and shall be effective as of the date last written below.

#### **11. Dispute Resolution**

In the event a dispute arises in connection with the validity, interpretation, implementation or alleged breach of this MOU, the parties shall attempt in the first instance to resolve such dispute through negotiation. If the dispute is not resolved through negotiation, then either party may refer the dispute for resolution to the Arbitration under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any subsequent enactment or amendment thereto, and the decision of the Arbitrator (whom shall be jointly appointed by both the parties) shall be binding upon both the parties. The seat of Arbitration shall be at Gurugram. The language of arbitration shall be English. The provisions of this Article shall survive the term/termination of this Agreement. Each party shall bear its own cost of the arbitration.

#### **12. Governing Law and Jurisdiction**

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive Central and State laws of India. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts between or among the parties arising out of or relating with this agreement shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Gurugram

#### **13. Partial Invalidity**

If any clause, paragraph, term or provision, of this MOU or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be invalid or unenforceable to any extent for any reason including by reason of any law or regulation or government policy, such clause, paragraph, term or provision shall be deemed severable and the remainder of the MOU shall remain valid and enforceable.



**14. Independent Contractors**

The status of the parties under this MOU shall be that of independent contractors. No party shall be authorized to waive any right or assume or create any contract or obligation of any kind in the name of, or on behalf of, the other or to make any statement that it has the authority to do so. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as establishing a partnership, joint venture, agency, employment or other similar relationship between the parties hereto.

**15. Indemnity**

Cyber Threat Haryana hereby undertakes and agrees to indemnify and keep and hold the Customer and its officers, directors, employees indemnified and harmless from and against all claims, proceedings, damages, losses, actions, costs and expenses arising out of or related to (i) any misrepresentation made by Cyber Threat Haryana during the performance of services; or (ii) any breach of terms and conditions of this MOU or (iii) by reason of any acts, defaults, deeds, things, omissions and commissions committed or omitted by the Cyber Threat Haryana including any third party claims for infringement of intellectual property rights.
