MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) is made and entered into on this 14th day of February 2023

BETWEEN

SGT University (hereinafter called "UNIVERSITY") established under Haryana Private Universities Act 2006, situated at Chandu Budhera, Gurgaon, on the **FIRST PART**

AND

Global Education Management Overseas Ltd (hereinafter called "GEM") Company No 05415393, having registered Office at 9 Amersham Hill Drive, High Wycombe, Bucks HP 13 6QX on the **SECOND PART**

WHEREAS

The purpose of this Agreement shall be the following as agreed between the parties:

- i) Cultural Exchange and Practical Training experiences for-graduates and undergraduates of the University
- ii) Exchange of academic information
- iii) Exchange of students and study programs
- iv) Exchange of faculty members
- v) Development of curriculum
- vi) Joint workshops
- vii) Internship programs for students
- viii) Joint research projects and any other area of mutual interest.

**IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO
AS FOLLOWS:-**

1. The University and GEM will collect the resumes of students interested in programme and arrange interaction of interested students with Global Education Management Ltd for exchanging information and offering career counseling support by using tools like Skype, telephone calls or in person.
2. In order to commence engagement, the program procedure, terms and conditions and fee structure, as mutually agreed between GEM and University, will be provided to students.
3. GEM will arrange support for students and others who wish to undertake any of the programs in fulfilment of the purpose of this agreement and meet the eligibility terms and conditions for registration, such as academic qualifications, level of English proficiency, relevant work experience and financial standing.
4. The parties agree that each party may publish or advertise the existence of the collaboration between the parties pursuant to this Memorandum and such collaborative activities undertaken in promotion of this Memorandum Provided that:
Prior approval of the other party shall be obtained on all such marketing and related materials before publication unless otherwise agreed in writing; each party shall meet its own cost for such marketing activities undertaken.
5. Each party hereby undertakes that it shall respond expeditiously to the other party in relation to any request for approval as required under this Memorandum of Understanding.

6. Financial obligations in regard to programs and exchanges will be discussed and agreed upon by both parties for each case individually.

7. The details of each article for any specific activity will be decided separately.

8. Confidentiality and Data Protection

All information should be kept confidential and private, and all data sufficiently stored and protected against misuse.

9. Amendments, Renewal and Termination

Amendments and additions may be made to this Memorandum of Understanding subject to the written mutual consent of both parties through separate agreements, as deemed necessary.

This Memorandum shall become effective once signed by both parties and will continue for 3 years from the date of signature. It can be further renewed by both parties on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

This Memorandum may be terminated by either party giving three (3) months prior written notice to the other.

The termination of this Memorandum shall not affect any collaborative activity, which shall continue in accordance with the terms and conditions agreed upon between the parties pertaining to that collaborative activity. Where no such separate terms and conditions were agreed upon, then the parties agree to ensure that upon the termination of this Memorandum, the interest of any students or staff of either party affected by the termination shall not be prejudiced, and the parties shall undertake suitable arrangements to safeguard the interest of the affected persons, including continuing such programs, courses or activities until completion by the affected persons.

10. Mutual indemnification

The parties agree that they shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless each other and their subsidiaries, successors, officers, directors and against any and all claims, demands, losses and liabilities arising directly or indirectly from the parties' acts or omissions related to or in performance of this agreement.

11. Dispute Resolution

This Memorandum is a statement of understanding only and is not intended to create a legally binding and enforceable agreement between the parties. In the event of any dispute arising out of this Memorandum of Understanding, all such disputes shall be settled mutually in an amicable manner.
