MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, CYBER SECURITY, RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT AND SHREE GURU GOBIND SINGH TRICENTENARY UNIVERSITY FOR COLLABORATION IN LEGAL ACTIVITIES

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is entered into on this day of 17th May 2024, by and between International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research and Development, having its registered office at 65A G/F Plot No-65, Laxmi Nagar, East Delhi, Pin Code-110092, represented by Dr. Shruti Bist, President, International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research. and Development (ICAICSRD), here in after referred to as "International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research, and Development, in the State of Delhi, duly registered under Companies Act, 2013 and under the Income Tax Act" and Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University, Gurugram, Gurugram-Badli Road Chandu, Budhera, Gurugram, Haryana-122505 represented by its Registrar, Dr. Joginder Yadav, hereinafter referred to as "SGT University."

Whereas International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research and Development (ICAICSRD) is umbrella organization that provides wide ambit of AI and cyber security solutions to Industries and Government and also works towards providing legal education relating to Cyber law and AI .It is an initiative of Shruti Bist Socio Legal Foundation Registered u/s8 of Companies Act 2013, Ministry of Corporate Affairs.

WHEREAS, SGT University is a reputable educational institution with a strong commitment to providing quality legal education through its FACULTY OF LAW, SGT UNIVERSITY;

WHEREAS, both parties recognize the mutual benefits of collaborating to enhance the legal education and related activities at FACULTY OF LAW, SGT UNIVERSITY

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE MOU

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is to promote Bilateral Cooperation between the Parties for mutual benefit, including International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research, and Development (ICAICSRD).

2. DURATION

This MOU shall be effective for a period of five (5) years, commencing on 17th May 2024, and shall remain in force until 16th May 2029, unless terminated earlier as provided in Clause 7.

3. COOPERATION AREAS

Both parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:

a. Academic Collaboration: The two parties will collaborate on organizing various Hackathons on AI, Health Care, Women safety, Cyber Laws, ADR etc. regularly in universities in collaboration with NITI Aayog and to promote startups.

b. Faculty Development: The two parties collaborate on webinars and conferences and other events to promote the organization and its work.

c. Student Exchange Programs: The parties will explore opportunities for collaborate on Artificial intelligence Courses and training and campus recruitment.

4. RESOURCES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 ICAICSRD Responsibilities:

- a. Provide expertise and guidance in curriculum development.
- b. Facilitate faculty development programs and workshops.
- c. Assist in organizing research initiatives and conferences.
- d. Collaborate on the establishment and operation of legal clinics.

4.2 SGT University Responsibilities:

- a. Implement the agreed-upon curriculum changes with the approval of university authorities.
- b. Nominate faculty members for development programs and workshops.
- c. Provide necessary infrastructure and support for joint initiatives.
- d. Ensure the active participation of Faculty of Law, SGT University students in collaborative activities.

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Each party's financial responsibilities and contributions will be determined on a case-by-case basis and outlined in separate written agreements, as necessary, for specific collaborative projects or activities under this MOU.



6. CONFIDENTIALITY

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary or sensitive information shared or material received orally or in writing and which is designated as "Confidential" or similar restrictive legend (hereinafter "Confidential Information") provided in connection with this MOU will be held and maintained in confidence, including this MOU and its annexes, and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the prior written consent of the disclosing party. The obligation upon the parties to protect the Confidential Information of the other under this MOU shall survive any expiration or termination of the relationship between the parties for any reason.

7. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this MOU by providing written notice of termination to the other party with a minimum of thirty (30) days of notice. Termination of this MOU shall not affect any ongoing collaborative projects, which will continue as agreed upon in separate agreements or addenda.

8. AMENDMENTS

This MOU may be amended only in writing and signed by both parties.

9. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive Central and State laws of India. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts between or among the parties arising out of or relating with this MOU shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Gurugram

10. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research and Development and SGT University with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior understandings, agreements, representations, and warranties, whether oral or written.

11. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS

The status of the parties under this MOU shall be that of independent contractors. No party shall be authorized to waive any right or assume or create any contractor obligation of any kind in the name of, or on behalf of, the other or to make any statement that it has the authority to do so. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as establishing a partnership, joint venture, agency, employment or other similar relationship between the parties hereto.

12. PARTIAL INVALIDITY:

If any clause, paragraph, term or provision of this MOU or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be invalid or unenforceable to any extent for any reason including by reason of any law or regulation or government policy, such clause, paragraph, term or provision shall be deemed several and the remainder of the MOU shall remain valid and enforceable.

13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

For the purposes of this MOU encompassing specific programs between International Council of Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Research and Development and SGT University it is understood and agreed that neither party shall be liable for any negligent or wrongful acts, either of commission or omission,

chargeable to the other, unless such liability is imposed by law. This MoU shall not be construed as seeking to either enlarge or diminish any obligation or duty owed by one party to the other or to a third party.
