



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding is executed on 18th day of May 2022 at New Delhi.

BETWEEN

SGT (SHREE GURU GOBIND SINGH TRICENTENARY) University, Budhera, Gurugram Badli Road, Gurgaon (Delhi NCR Region) herewith known as party 1 is a private university established in 2013 and is empowered to award degrees as specified by UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956. Through its Registrar, duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of SGT University (hereinafter referred to as 'SGT University') PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.

AND

M/s SHINE FOUNDATION, 18-20, K G Marg, New Delhi-110001, INDIA, through their Program Director presently Mr. Dhiraj Virmani in this regard, (hereinafter referred to as SF), herewith known as party-2, engaged in outreach activities & services, PARTY OF THE SECOND PART. Party 1 & Party 2 will be known as Parties.

The expression of SGT University and SF, mean and include the Institutions/Organizations, their successors, appointees, assignees etc.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH:

1. Party 2, will be a 'Outreach Activities Affiliate' and 'Collaborator' of SGT University.
2. There will be collaboration between the various student volunteers of faculties of SGT University and the executive of Party 2 in the areas of joint and integrated outreach interests.
3. This collaboration will extend the facilities of the two entities for complementing joint outreach projects and to train each other's students'/research scholars/teachers from Party 1 and executives and program coordinators from party 2.

4. The two parties will conduct joint programs including short term courses and training modules as per mutual interest.
5. Wherever there is potential for program funding from national/international agencies, the applications for such funding in areas of mutual interest may be prepared jointly for application after obtaining permission of the Competent Authorities of the two parties.
6. Both Parties will independently cover the cost of other expenditure of outreach activities incurred in connection with the research collaboration.
7. Party 2 will provide short-term training to students and faculty members of the SGT University in their areas of specialization on the request from the University.
8. Executives from party 2 may be invited to deliver lectures in specific courses or seminars of SGT University.
9. Publications in scientific journals shall be jointly shared by SF and SGT University.
10. The initial tenure of this MOU is for a period for three years from the date of signing of MoU. This MOU may be amended / extended for specified duration by mutual consent in writing of both the parties.
11. This MOU may be terminated by either institution at any time provided that the terminating institution gives to other party written notice of intention to terminate at least six months prior to termination. However, all commitments made by the parties shall be completed in such eventualities as agreed.
12. A joint committee shall be constituted to periodically review the progress of this MoU. Both the parties shall nominate a single point of contact to communicate and evaluate the joint activities.
13. Any dispute arising out of this Memorandum of Understanding or in its enforcement the concerned parties to this MoU will resolve the same amicably. However, in case if the dispute remains unresolved it shall be referred to a committee of arbitrator to be appointed by mutual consent of both the parties subject to Delhi jurisdiction. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the party concerned. If the matter still remains unresolved, the same shall be referred to a team of three arbitrators, one each appointee by the parties and third arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of two arbitrators who will be common. If the matter

still remains un resolved, the same shall be dealt with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation, Act 1996 as amended from time to time.

14. Both the parties shall meet the financial liabilities at their own and if necessary, special agreement for financial liabilities may be agreed for each activity, which will be point of this MoU.
