**Governance & Review**

- All scholarships will be Monitored by **Scholarship Committee**
- Annual **Scholarship Impact Report** published for transparency.
- Reviewed every **year** to remain relevant to changing needs



### **General Conditions (Applicable to All Scholarships)**

1. **Non-Transferable** – Scholarships are non-transferable and apply only to the program and academic session for which they are awarded.
2. **One Scholarship Rule** – A student can avail only **one scholarship** at a time. If eligible under multiple categories, the **highest scholarship benefit** will be awarded.
3. **Minimum Academic Performance** – Continuation of scholarships under category of Meritorious Student Scholarship (UG/PG) – Subsequent Years: the student must fulfil the following conditions:
  - a) The student must have secured 75% or above aggregate marks and must have passed all subjects in the first attempt.
  - b) The student must have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance in all theory and practical subjects.
  - c) The student must have cleared all previous dues payable to the University.
  - d) The student must not be involved in any act of indiscipline, including ragging, eve-teasing, or any misconduct as defined by University rules.
  - e) The student must not be availing any other scholarship or financial assistance from any Government / Government organization / Institute.
  - f) The student must submit a Scholar Project, to their respective deans, to claim the scholarship for subsequent year

### **Note**

Students must apply for continuation of the scholarship to their respective Dean within one month of the declaration of results or as per the notification issued by the University.

The Competent Authority of the University reserves the right to modify, amend, change, or withdraw any terms, conditions, or slabs of the Scholarship Policy at any time without prior notice.

4. **Disciplinary Record** – The scholarship will be withdrawn if the student is found guilty of any **disciplinary misconduct, use of unfair means in examination, or violation of university regulations**.
5. **Periodic Review** – All scholarships are subject to **review by the Scholarship Committee** each semester/year, and continuance will depend on consistent performance and compliance.
6. **Fee Payment** – Scholarships are applicable only against the **tuition fee**. Other charges (hostel, transport, examination, registration, etc.) must be borne by the student.



7. **University’s Authority** – The decision of the **Vice Chancellor, SGT University**, shall be final and binding in all matters of scholarship grant, continuation, modification, or withdrawal.

**Policy on Multiple Scholarships**

- A student is only eligible for one type of scholarship or concession per academic year. If they qualify for multiple awards (e.g., sports and domicile), they will receive the one that provides the highest financial benefit, not both.
