CHAPTER -2

Faculties of the University:

The university is imparting education for various courses through its following 17 Faculties:

1. Faculty of Medicine & Health Sciences

The Medical Education Complex is a beautifully architected and landscaped structure both from utility and aesthetic point of view. The serene and spacious environs have earned the distinction of being one of the best medical complexes. The well-planned, ultramodern medical education complex houses the 600 bedded Multi-Specialty Teaching Hospital and hostels for boys and girls with excellent dining section and sports complex. Adequate residential accommodation is available for staff and students.

Medical College building is an ultramodern structure and houses administration block, conference hall, department-wise lecture galleries, laboratories, demo rooms, research labs and libraries. The campus has a full-fledged communication centre, auditorium, canteen & dining halls and vast play grounds. The college is very spacious, aesthetically built and has the entire clinical, para clinical and basic medical services departments. The environment in the college is very conducive to concentrated learning and study.

Eminent doctors and teaching professors who are highly qualified with decades of experience are the backbone of college. The highly dedicated SGT Medical team always strives to improve the health standards by making health system more effective and responsive to the needs of the people. The faculty in the last year had varied experience of attending national & International conferences, symposiums and CME's.

Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary Hospital is a 600 bedded hospital attached to the college. It is a well-equipped, multispecialty hospital with the most advanced facilities in this area catering to the needs of rural and urban population around Gurgaon. The hospital has experienced consultants in all specialties such as Surgery, Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedics, TB & Chest, Psychiatry, Skin & DVD, Radiology and Anaesthesiology.

The hospital has got modern amenities for Diagnosis & Treatment including C.T. Scan, MRI, Colour Doppler, Ultrasound, X-ray, Auto analyzer, Multi-Para monitors, Ventilators etc. The Intensive Cardiac Care Unit (ICCU), Intensive care unit (ICU), Respiratory Intensive care unit (RICU), Surgical post-operative critical care unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU),

Under the tutelage of highly trained and productive faculty, the student acquires a solid foundation in the various subjects.

The faculty proudly possesses the complete know-how to prepare learned & well qualified professionals. Our dental college also organizes special scientific activities like lectures & scientific presentations by well-known academicians from different parts of country and also international exposure in the past in form of annual academic exchange program with University of Detroit Mercy, Michigan, USA. The students of this college have topped in university exams & got medals in different subjects. They have won various Awards and trophies in inter college sports and other co-curricular competitions also. Our faculty and post graduates are always involved actively in publication of various scientific articles, textbooks and various editorials. All in our ever-growing publications list stand over more than 500 scientific publications.

3. Faculty of Nursing

The faculty houses 5 different specialty departments namely Obstetrics and Gynecological Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Medical Surgical Nursing, Child Health Nursing & Mental Health Nursing.

4. Faculty of Allied Health Sciences

Tremendous expansion of the healthcare industry brings with it a growing demand for trained allied professionals. In order to cater to this demand to whatever extent possible, SGT University entered in the field of allied health education with the introduction of degree and diploma courses in subjects such as Medical Laboratory Technology, Operation Theater Technology, Radio-Imaging Technology and degree course in Optometry. The Faculty also introduced specialized graduation courses in Neurophysiology Technology, Nutrition and Dietetics and Sleep Science; Post-graduate courses in Medical Laboratory Technology, Operation Theatre Technology, Radio-Imaging Technology and Nutrition & Dietetics and B.Sc. Microbiology to cope up with the market need for specialized technical professionals. All the courses offered by the Faculty are approved by Govt. of Haryana.

6. Faculty of Commerce and Management

9. Faculty of Engineering and Technology

Faculty of Engineering and Technology (FET) was established in the year 2015. FET is ranked 4th in India by Times Engineering Survey 2016 conducted by Times of India. FET comprises of five Departments: Civil Engineering (CE), Computer Science Engineering (CSE), Electrical and Communication Engineering (ECE), Mechanical Engineering (ME) and Applied Sciences and Humanities (ASH). FET have M. Tech programs in CSE, ECE, CE and ME and a unique Masters program in Technology Management (MTM) as integrated B. Tech-MBA program. FET also has a Centre for Languages and Communication to take care of foreign language courses for the students. M. Tech students are selected on the basis of merit.

FET has demonstrated its excellence in research in many areas as a vibrant university atmosphere with the combination of strong academic and research activities. Both compliment each other and the students at all levels under the able guidance of the faculty members maintain this brilliant combination and help the Institute to reach the zenith of knowledge and innovation.

FET follows Semester system for evaluating students. FET uses following Teaching Learning methods such as Quiz, Assignments, Case Studies, Roll Play, Model Making, Seminar, Internships, Industrial Visits, Project Based Study, Tutorial, Surprise Test, Soft skills, GDs, Guest Lecture and International Faculty Inputs. The main focus is on Practical Learning using Project as part of curriculum, Project Labs, Spoken Tutorial Lab, Online Test, Onsite Learning, Participation in Competition, Regular Review of Projects. FET has fully equipped E-classrooms, Intranet with Faculty PPT subjects, Online Expert Lecture (Spoken Tutorial), E-Journals with easy access and On-line discussion forum (with Google Handouts).

FET is a prestigious Institute of higher learning producing meritorious students with excellent career growth. The students get the best of opportunities in the form of highly advanced courses, eminent faculty members, well-equipped laboratories, library, hostels and immense facilities to excel in research and development. The selection procedure for students at undergraduate, postgraduate and research level is highly stringent so that FET gets the best brains of India. Highly scientific and innovative technology is used for teaching and carrying out research activities.

10. Faculty of Mass Communication and Media Technology

The Faculty of Mass Communication and Media Technology in SGT University aims at preparing students to be able to work in the core fields of Mass Communication like Print Media, Digital Photography, Radio Production, Advertising, Public Relations, Television Production and Event Management. The emphasis is on using a ‘hands on’ approach in teaching with a view to making the students industry ready as soon as they complete their course. Besides the B.A. (Journalism and Mass Communication) which the Faculty started in 2014-15, B.Sc. (Film Making) will be offered from the academic session 2016-17.

11. Faculty of Physical Sciences

Faculty of Physical Sciences came into the existence in year 2014 with B.Sc. (Non medical). The B.Sc. (Hons in Mathematics), M.Sc. (Physics), M.Sc. (Chemistry) and M.Sc. was started in the academic year 2015.

Since earlier days to today's modern world, the pursuit of mankind is almost same but in the process of coming of age we have gathered enormous information & knowledge about the matter and in addition to this now we are in a better position that how properties of matter can be exploited for the benefits of mankind. Therefore the science or information that has been gathered along this journey is known as Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics. Even the most sought after technologies in modern world bearing an altogether different nomenclature have same progenitor i.e. Chemistry and Physics. For the invention and innovation of existing & new technologies the knowledge of chemistry and physics is not only a prelude but it also gives clues for altogether new thinking platform to achieve the objectives in research & technologies. Moreover the mushrooming industrial development at the cost of environment has raised concerned about the environment therefore the search for green technologies has become essential. Therefore the search for green technology will depend on our understanding of physical & chemical nature of matter and hence will offer clues for green technologies.

12. Faculty of Behavioural Sciences

With a faculty team renowned for its academic credentials, Clinical Psychology department has earned recognition for its unique style of teaching and experiential learning. The keen pursuit of research in different areas of psychology, especially clinical psychology, along-with the active role in participation and organization of seminars and workshop the teaching faculty of the department have contributed a lot in academics.

The Faculty of Behavioural Sciences offers three courses, namely, B.Sc. (Clinical Psychology), M.Sc. (Clinical/Counseling Psychology), Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling.

The mission of faculty will continue to keep engaged in teaching and research programmes and enhance its capacity to offer the education in order to direct and increase understanding about mental health, human behavior, human development, learning and other activity. The degree holders in this discipline have ample job opportunities in a variety of sectors such as education, counselors in educational institutions from schools to universities, hospitals, etc.

13. Faculty of India Medical System

The practice of Ayurveda as a health care tool has been in vogue in Indian subcontinent since ancient times. The rejuvenation of this Indian medical system started with the independence of India. Presently, Department of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy, abbreviated as AYUSH, is a governmental body in India which is responsible for promotion of Ayurvedic education and research.

Under the guidelines of Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM), the University has started BAMS programme of 4-year duration from the academic session 2015-16. The course curriculum has been developed in such a manner that the BAMS degree holders will be competent to establish their own clinics as well as compete with their companions from other BAMS training institutes. This programme offers ample job opportunities for holders of BAMS degree in private and public sector hospitals and opens vistas for self-employment. The faculty through its industrial visits and academic scientific programs have really niched an environment where students are surging ahead in the field of Ayurveda.

14. SGT College of Pharmacy

SGT College of Pharmacy is a pivotal institution with immense potential to carry forward the learning of Pharmaceutical Sciences. SGT University established SGT College of Pharmacy from the academic session 2015-16 with the approval of Pharmacy Council of India. Initially, the College has offered two courses, namely, B. Pharm. and D. Pharm. The University envisages to start postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in near future.

We are proud to have highly qualified faculty members who have earlier worked at prestigious universities like Delhi University, Punjab University, Jamia Hamdard University etc. Currently SGT college of Pharmacy has two Professors, one with specialization in Pharmaceutical Chemistry and another in Pharmaceutics. Six of the faculty members are PhD Holders and remaining twelve members are M. Pharmacy from prestigious Universities.

The College has rich collection of books in its library with internet facilities, and subscribes to over 70 e-journals and about 20 international print journals. Its labs are well-equipped with modern equipments. The faculty has rich experience of both academia and industry at the both governmental and private levels.

The Faculty members at SGT College of Pharmacy have collectively participated in 36 conferences, whereas presented 13 posters at various conferences, made oral presentations at 3 seminars. The senior faculty members have delivered lectures at 6 locations and chaired approximately 7 scientific sessions.

15. Faculty of Agricultural Sciences

Visualising the demand of Agriculture Scientists in different public and private sectors in comparison to their supply, the SGT University has envisaged to establish Faculty of Agricultural Sciences w.e.f. academic session 2016-17. Presently, the faculty is offering B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture 4 year programme.

The faculty has state-of-art facilities in terms of air conditioned class rooms equipped with all teaching tools and its well developed laboratories are housed with latest equipment and instruments. The faculty also maintains orchard gardening areas along with animal farm for understanding composite farming system and imparting practical exposure to the participants.

The University has appointed experienced, well qualified and dedicated faculties members along with renowned adjunct teachers to deal with specialized area of the discipline. In the teaching pedagogy, apart from the class room and laboratory exercises, the students are assigned live projects and visits to the relevant Industries. To develop entrepreneurship amongst the students, they are provided with independent field area for full cropping season so that they can practically learn how to grow and maintain the crops.

Along with their teaching assignments the faculty members are carrying out research projects on the latest developments in their respective specialities. And, hence, the focus of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences is on conceptual, experimental and personality development of the students so that after completion of the course they are ready to serve the public /private industry or to start their own profession.

16. Faculty of Education

As focused in the New Education Policy, 2016 that the teacher is the fulcrum around which foundation education revolves. Therefore, for the better exposure and to make the teacher more accountable the NCTE has developed new pedagogy and course curriculum of two years instead of one year. Estimating the wide gap between the requirement and the availability of school teachers in the country after obtaining authorization from state government and approval from NCTE, the SGT University has founded the faculty of Education w.e.f. Academic Session 2016-2017 to offer two year full time B.Ed. Programme with an intake of 100 seats. The main focus of the Faculty of Education is to facilitate learning among the prospective teachers and equip them with essential skills followed by strong values and professional ethics.

In terms of the infrastructural facilities, the Faculty maintains air conditioned and ceiling mounted LCD projector classrooms. Psychology lab is equipped with experimental and testing tools which facilitate to conduct 44 psychological tests. The three sectional science lab which is attributed to physics, chemistry, and life science are housed with all required equipments to conduct demonstration, experiments and to take up teacher education projects. Apart this, the faculty provides a range of teaching learning recourses to the students like 60 pieces computer lab well stocked library, magazines, journals, communications lab, Wi-fi campus and nearby schools of adopted villages by the university. Under the internship programme the B.Ed. trainees are involved in school planning, teaching, assessment, and interaction with teachers, community members, and children. They are also engaged in writing reflective journals, develop case studies, and conduct action research.

To accomplish objective the Faculty of Education has appointed well experienced, qualified and dedicated teachers who are not only engaged in managing classes rather organize and participate in seminars, conferences, workshops and Faculty Development Programmes. In the area of research the faculty has constituted a good amount of articles in reputed journals.

17. Faculty of Fashion & Design

As we live in an Art cultured designed world and, hence, it is an ideal time to study the business of design and art culture that provides a unique and deeply relevant context in which to do it. SGT University always supports new and critical innovations in every field of life through real world projects

In this context, SGT University established the Faculty of Fashion in the academic year 2016-17 for different level of fashion courses, i.e undergraduate, post graduate and research in fashion. However, initially the Faculty has decided to offer only 4 years Bachelors degree in design. The course curriculum developed on the basis of corporate demands that includes the core depth of the concepts, Internships and projects to enhances the student's knowledge and core strength.

To develop skilled budding designers, the University set up all the required modern and advanced laboratories namely Pattern making, Apparel Construction lab, Draping lab, Dyeing & Printing lab, Lifestyle Product Construction lab, Illustration lab, Quality Control lab, Photography lab and Workshop to develop innovate ideas and their applications to create new products. Apart this, the faculty maintains a resource center where student can display the innovative products for the retailing purpose.

Only by creating best infrastructure the objective of the faculty is not accomplished until and unless the best teachers are available. Therefore, keeping in mind, the University appointed well qualified and experienced faculty members for professionally grooming the fashion students. The faculty members have graduated from renowned fashion institutes/Universities like NIFT, Delhi University, University of Allahabad, TITS, etc. who are dedicated and expertise in their respective fields. The overall vision of the Faculty is to provide quality education to bring the nation up to the mark globally.

University Library

CHAPTER - 6

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

(As per 1st Ordinance of the University)

Admissions in the University are made strictly on the basis of merit. The merit for admission is determined either on the basis of marks or grades obtained in the entrance test conducted by University or the marks obtained in the qualifying examination. However, the admissions in professional and technical courses are made only through an entrance test.

Unfilled / dropout vacant seats in professional and technical courses are filled up by the University at their own level by considering the marks obtained by the applicants in the qualifying examination and on the basis of their inter-se-merit.
