Report of the Visit:

a) Introduction:

On the 12th March ,2024, the Faculty of Behavioural Sciences, SGT University organized a day visit to The Earth Saviours Foundation, located at Bandhwari Village, Gurgaon and to say it was an enriching experience for the trainees. Students were given a brief introduction about the NGO.

Ravi Kalra is a well-known Karma Yogi, social activist and environmentalist. He is also known as the “No Honking Man of India.” In the year 2008, he founded an NGO by the name of “The Earth Saviours Foundation” to look after poor, mentally disabled, wounded, deprived people, HIV/

AIDS patients, abandoned senior citizens and less privileged people. He offers them free shelter, food, medicine and daily amenities. Now, Sh. Jas Kalra, his son, runs the organisation under his able leadership as President. Today, around 1000 less privileged people are living permanently in our NGO's shelter homes located at Bandhwari Village and Mandawar Village, Distt. The Earth Saviours Foundation is registered under 80G of Income Tax Exemption Act and FCRA license from The Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India.

Some of the facilities and amenities provided by the NGO for the abandoned senior citizens, mentally disabled, bed ridden people, HIV infected, people suffering with incurable disease and other less privileged people, they regularly take their residents / patients to different hospitals for routine checkups and medical treatment, Counseling, have round the clock facility of Ambulances for transporting patients to different hospitals during emergencies, find opportunities to rehabilitate the residents, find possibilities to unite them back with their families, In routine they organize extra curriculum activities such as Bhajan Sandhyas, Kirtans, celebration of different festivals and entertainment for the residents to offer joy, happiness and hope to live with dignity, in routine they organize medical checkup camps, their in-house first aid medical service is active round the clock. Presently around 500 abandoned senior citizens and disabled people are living permanently at gurukul located at Bandhwari Village, Gurgaon, all the basic facilities including dormitory accommodation, hygienically prepared meals, medical facilities and day to day needs are completely free of charge. Sometimes the abandoned and disabled people are brought to old age home in critical conditions. Most of the them are bed-ridden, handicapped, HIV infected, on death bed or having maggots all over their body. Despite of the care some of them die due to old age or constant long illness. They also ensure that their last rites are performed with full respect and dignity according to their respective religion. The Earth Saviours Foundation has opened a rescue center for mentally disabled people. This is offering round the clock free accommodation, food, medical treatment and day to day facilities. The Delhi Police also bring abandoned people to the NGO where admission is provided without any cost. Even the Govt. Ministries and the Govt. recognized hospitals also send regularly abandoned people and patients to be admitted in Gurukul (NGO). Students got the opportunity to interact with the inmates and engage in observation of the

b) Objective of the Visit:

The visit was planned with the aim to provide students an opportunity to visit the Earth Saviours Foundation, located at Bandhwari Village, Gurgaon and to get an exposure of working at an NGO and interacting with the inmates along with providing brief psychological interventions to the inmates.

c) Brief content of lecture- Introduction of the organization was provided to the trainees in terms of its establishment, the founders along with the nature of their work, their functioning and brief profile of the inmates was explained.
